Learning

Our main theme for this half term will be 'Ourselves' in our 'All about be Me' topic, followed by 'Animals and their Habitats' Autumn term 1, allows us the opportunity to get to know the children and create an environment where they can thrive in their learning whilst enjoying their time in school. During this term we will be learning our class rules and routines. We will be taking part in circle time activities to help us build friendships. We will learn about our families and the community. We will be discussing what is healthy and unhealthy food and how we can look after our bodies. We will be exploring the different areas in school and outside in the playground. We will be learning about the different seasons. We will be developing our gross and fine motor skills to help us with our mark-making and writing. In our number sessions we will be learning to count orally as well as touch counting. We will be learning new rhymes in our rhyme time sessions. Reception will be starting their phonics sessions and learning lots of new letters sounds!
